1. Doi Suthep Temple & Hmong Hill Tribe Village

Half Day Trip (Morning / Afternoon)

Doi Suthep Temple is a sacred place of worship dating back to 1383. Visitors can climb the 309-step staircase flanked by Naga serpents to reach the golden stupa on the hilltop, enjoying spectacular panoramic views of Chiang Mai City. The trip includes a visit to the Hmong Hill Tribe Village (Hmong Doi Pui), nestled in Doi Suthep-Pui National Park, where you can experience their colorful traditional costumes, quaint hillside lifestyle, and local cultural museum.

Note / What to bring: Shoulders and knees must be covered for temple entry.

SHORT ITINERARY

08:30 / 13:30	Depart for Doi Suthep Mountain
09:00 / 14:00	Visit Doi Suthep Temple & enjoy panoramic viewpoints
10:30 / 15:30	Visit Hmong Hill Tribe Village & Local Cultural Museum
12:00 / 17:00	Transfer back to hotels

2. City Temple & Museum Tour

Half Day Trip (Morning / Afternoon)

Explore Chiang Mai's rich historical and cultural heritage along its historic city moat. Visit key ancient temples: Wat Phra Singh (stunning Lanna architecture and Viharn), Wat Chedi Luang (home to Chiang Mai's largest historic stupa), and Wat Chiang Man (the city's oldest temple). You will also visit the Chiang Mai City Arts & Cultural Centre to gain deep insights into Lanna history and traditions from past to present.

Note / What to bring: Shoulders and knees must be covered for temple entry.

3. Elephant Nature Park (Half Day Morning Visit)

Half Day Morning Visit

Founded by renowned elephant rights advocate Saengduean 'Lek' Chailert, Elephant Nature Park (ENP) is Asia's pioneering ethical elephant rescue & rehabilitation sanctuary. Spend quality time observing rescued elephants in natural river and jungle surroundings with a strict no-riding policy. Learn their inspiring rescue histories and support sustainable animal welfare.

Note / What to bring: Hat, sunscreen, bug repellent, walking shoes/sandals, camera, refillable water bottle (rain jacket in May-Oct).

08:00 AM	Hotel Pick-up: Convenient round-trip transfer from Chiang Mai hotel
09:30 AM	Arrival & Guided Walk: Educational walk with park guides & elephants (no riding); observe natural river habitat
12:00 PM	Vegan Buffet Lunch: Enjoy a rich Asian & International vegan buffet
01:00 PM	Return Transfer: Depart park for 1-hour drive back to Chiang Mai hotel or ENP city office

Includes: Round-trip hotel transfer, Asian & International vegan buffet lunch, All park entrance fees, Knowledgeable English-speaking guide, Full activity insurance coverage.

Excludes: Personal souvenirs & tips.

4. Kerchor Elephant Eco Park (Ethical Sanctuary)

Full Day / Half Day Options

Kerchor Elephant ECO Park is a community-based sustainable elephant sanctuary run by local Karen people. Riding is strictly prohibited. Guests interact with elephants in their natural habitat, learn their lifestyle, prepare herbal medicine balls, enjoy mud spa sessions, and bathe with them in the river. Income supports elephant conservation, habitat protection, and local community welfare.

Note / What to bring: Bring spare clothes, swimwear/towel, and slip-on sandals.

Activities	Thai Elephant Lifestyle introduction, Feed & play, Prepare herbal medicine, Jungle walk, Mud spa & River bathing, Traditional Thai meal.

Excludes: Personal souvenirs & tips.

5. Elephant Conservation Center (Lampang)

Full Day Trip

Visit the government-operated Thai Elephant Conservation Center in Lampang, home to Thailand's premier Elephant Hospital and Nursery. Experience gentle giant care, daily elephant bathing, and demonstrations. The tour also visits the magnificent 13th-century Wat Phra That Lampang Luang (a masterwork of Lanna architecture) followed by a charming horse-drawn carriage ride through local villages.

Note / What to bring: Respectful temple attire required (covered shoulders & knees).

SHORT ITINERARY

08:00	Pick up from hotel and depart for Lampang Province
09:30	Arrive at Elephant Conservation Center; visit Hospital & Nursery
10:30	Observe daily elephant bathing & natural behavior demonstration
12:00	Lunch at local restaurant
13:30	Depart to Wat Phra That Lampang Luang & explore complex
14:30	Horse Carriage ride through local village (approx. 15-20 mins)
16:00	Return to Chiang Mai with local market stop along the way
16:30	Arrive back in Chiang Mai and hotel drop-off

Includes: Round-trip transfer (VIP 9-seat van), English guide, Entrance fees, Lunch, Horse carriage, Drinking water, Travel insurance.

Excludes: Personal expenses, Optional activities.

6. Chiang Rai Day Trip (White Temple & Golden Triangle)

Full Day Trip

A popular day trip to Thailand's northernmost province. Stop at Mae Kachan Natural Hot Springs, visit the iconic Wat Rong Khun (White Temple), explore the ancient city of Chiang Saen (Wat Chedi Luang), and reach the world-famous Golden Triangle (meeting point of Thailand, Laos & Myanmar). Take a long-tail boat trip along the Mekong River and visit the House of Opium Museum. (Passport Required!)

Note / What to bring: Comfortable clothes. Original Passport MUST be carried.

07:00	Depart for Chiang Rai (Pick-up @ 06:50)
08:30	Break at Mae Kachan Hot Springs
10:00	Visit Wat Rong Khun (White Temple) & Chiang Saen Ancient City
12:30	Buffet Lunch at Golden Triangle
13:30	Visit Opium Museum & Mekong River Long-tail Boat Trip
15:30	Depart back to Chiang Mai (approx. 4 hrs) with coffee/tea break
19:30	Arrive in Chiang Mai and drop-off at hotels

7. Doi Inthanon National Park & Soft Trek

Full Day Trip

Journey to Thailand's highest peak at Doi Inthanon National Park. Experience lush cloud forest, cool climate, and majestic waterfalls. Take a guided soft trek along the Pha Dok Siew Nature Trail with a local Karen guide, passing terraced rice fields and waterfalls. Visit the Karen hill tribe village of Mae Klang Luang for fresh local coffee, explore the King & Queen Twin Royal Pagodas, and shop at the Hmong Tribal Market.

Note / What to bring: Light clothing with jacket/sweater (cool weather at peak) & hiking shoes.

09:30	Reach Thailand's Highest Peak & explore Pha Dok Siew Trail
11:30	Visit King & Queen Twin Pagodas and Hmong Market

14:00	Visit Mae Klang Luang Karen Village (Coffee tasting) & Wachirathan Waterfall
17:00	Arrive in Chiang Mai and drop-off at hotels

8. Chiang Mai Night Safari

Evening Trip

Experience the excitement of the world's second nocturnal zoo. Ride open-air trams through two distinct wildlife zones: the Savanna Safari Zone and the Predator Prowl Zone. Observe nocturnal wildlife from around the globe in naturalistic enclosures and feed friendly herbivores. Walk the 1.2 km Jaguar Trail around the tranquil Swan Lake and enjoy the spectacular Musical Fountain & Water Screen show.

Note / What to bring: Casual comfortable evening attire.

17:30 - 18:00	Hotel pick-up and depart for Night Safari
18:45	Explore wildlife along Jaguar Trail Walking Zone
19:30	Take Tram Rides for North Zone (Carnivores) & South Zone (Savanna)
20:30	Enjoy Musical Fountain Show & Night Performances
21:00 - 22:00	Transfer back to hotels

Includes: Round-trip transfer, VIP van, English guide, Tram tickets & Entrance fees, Drinking water, Insurance.

Excludes: Dinner, Animal food baskets, Personal expenses.

9. Khantoke Dinner & Cultural Performances

Evening Trip

Immerse yourself in authentic Northern Thai Lanna culture. Enjoy a traditional Khantoke dinner served on low pedestal tray tables featuring authentic local dishes such as Chiang Mai curry, fried pork, sticky rice, and local dips. While dining, enjoy classical Lanna dance performances including the Fingernail Dance, Sword Dance, and Candle Dance. The show concludes with vibrant performances by hill tribe communities (Akha, Yao, Lahu, Hmong) and a visit to a local night market.

Note / What to bring: Smart casual attire.

19:00	Welcome & seated for traditional Khantoke Dinner
19:45	Enjoy Lanna Classical Dances & Hill Tribe Cultural Performances
21:00	Transfer back to town with optional drop at local market or hotel

Includes: Round-trip transfer, VIP van, English guide, Khantoke Dinner, Refillable soft drinks & water, Cultural show tickets, Insurance.

Excludes: Alcoholic beverages, Personal expenses.

10. Handicraft Village (Sankampaeng & Bor Sang)

Half Day Trip (Morning / Afternoon)

Discover Chiang Mai's legendary cottage craft industries along Sankampaeng Road. Visit Bor Sang Umbrella Village, famous for handmade paper and silk umbrellas. Explore renowned local craft factories demonstrating centuries-old Lanna artisan wisdom: Celadon ceramic pottery, Thai Silk weaving, Silverware crafting, Lacquerware, and Gems gallery. Observe artisans at work and purchase genuine mastercrafts.

Note / What to bring: Casual comfortable attire.

09:00 / 14:00	Visit Bor Sang Umbrella Making Center
09:45 / 14:45	Visit Thai Silk, Silverware, Celadon & Lacquerware Workshops
12:00 / 17:00	Transfer back to hotels

Includes: Round-trip transfer (VIP van), Professional English guide, Admission fees, Drinking water & cold towel, Insurance.

Excludes: Personal shopping & optional tours.

Prior to setting off, professional instructors provide a practice session in a training field to evaluate driving skills and select the most appropriate jungle route.

Note / What to bring: Outdoor athletic clothes, closed-toe shoes, sunglasses.

Terms & Conditions

1. BOOKING & RESERVATIONS

- Office Hours: Daily 08:00 - 20:00
- Morning & Full Day Tours: Bookings accepted up to 20:00 the day prior.
- Afternoon Programs: Same-day booking available until 10:00 AM.
- Evening Programs (Khantoke / Night Safari): Same-day booking available until 15:00 PM.
- All bookings require Full Names and Passport Numbers for all travelers (insurance purposes).

2. CHILDREN POLICY

- Infants under 3 years: FREE of charge (or specific baby rates per park policy).
- Children 4-8 years (< 120 cm height): Child price applies.
- Children under 9 years (> 120 cm height): Adult price applies.
- Children 10 years and above: Adult price applies.

3. CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY

- Full Day & Morning Trips: > 24 hrs prior = Free cancellation | 12-24 hrs = 50% charge | < 12 hrs / No Show = 100% charge.
- Afternoon & Evening Trips: > 12 hrs prior = Free cancellation | 6-12 hrs = 50% charge | < 6 hrs / No Show = 100% charge.
- Unused tour features or early departures are strictly non-refundable.

4. OPERATIONAL NOTES

- Elephant riding is strictly prohibited on ethical sanctuary tours.
- Minimum 6 adults required for most group join-in tours (unless specified otherwise).
- Optional side trips are not permitted on join-in itineraries.
